

### Getting Started

What's the best thing about a cold winter for you? The worst?

#### Word

Read aloud 1 Samuel 16:1-13

1. Saul was the first king of Israel, but he had failed to be the kind of king God wanted for his people. Chapter 15 of 1 Samuel ends with: "And the Lord was sorry that he had made Saul king over Israel." Chapter 16 details how God chooses a new king.
2. Enjoy the story of how God works through Samuel to choose David. What do you notice? Questions?
3. God chooses the least likely son of Jesse to be king. Can you think of other stories of Scripture when God chooses the least likely person for a task? What does this teach us about God?
4. God works through some "least likely" people in the Scripture. What does this mean for our life with him today?
5. Invite two people in your group to share their **Faith Story in 100 Words** using the series questions as a guide (see other side of this sheet for the questions). Reflect together on what you hear—how are the stories similar? Different? Ask the people sharing their stories to talk about what the process of writing their stories was like. What did they discover?

#### Share

Invite the people in your group to share any blessings or concerns they have from the past week.

#### Prayer

Pray for each other in sentence prayers.
