Word

1. Throughout the Old Testament God guided His people using different forms of leadership...priests, judges, prophets, kings. Last week we heard about King David. This week we hear about how Samuel, who anointed David to be king, was born. This is Hannah's story.
2. Read aloud 1 Samuel 1:1-20. What do you glean about Hannah's life? What drew her to God?
3. Hannah's outward situation looked bleak. She poured out her heart to God confident that God would hear her. She had faith, hope, and confidence in God. Hannah's faith story included thanksgiving and praise to God (1 Samuel chapter 2). Why is this important?
4. Have you ever wanted something desperately (as Hannah longed for a son)? You may or may not want to share this personal story with your group, but could you share what you learned in the waiting?
5. Invite two people in your group to share their **Faith Story in 100 Words** using the series questions as a guide (see other side of this sheet for the three questions). Reflect together on what you hear--how are the stories similar? Different? Ask the people sharing their stories to talk about what the process of writing their stories was like. What did they discover?
